

DECLARATION OF COMMITMENT WITH CHILDREN

AMO HOTELS, aware that the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of minors throughout the world is a problem that involves the Tourism Industry, assumes the will of :

1. Train the staff to detect possible cases of child abuse.
2. Provide information to customers.
3. Provide information to relevant persons for follow-up of possible cases.
4. Report annually on the implementation of these points.

Therefore, it assumes the implementation of actions and good practices aimed at eradicating the problem, incorporating the following commitments into its Social Responsibility policies:

1. Promote Human Rights and, in particular, the Rights of children.
2. Reject, repress and condemn the exploitation of human beings, in any of its forms, especially sexual and in particular when it affects minors.
3. Adopt preventive measures to prevent the elaboration or diffusion of tourist programs that promote or encourage sexual contacts with minors.
